

Executive Board Eligibility

Nominee's must have a minimum of two (2) years of experience, either as an employee or volunteer with a Missouri Department of Agriculture licensed facility; or as a public health official, veterinarian, law enforcement official, animal control officer or humane investigator.

Upon request by the board, an Executive Board member nominee shall provide written verification of working or volunteering for a minimum of 250 hours within the two most recent years with an ACFA licensed facility or recognized animal welfare organization;

The nominee for the Executive Board must be a current member in good standing and have been a member of the Association from the prior calendar year.

Nominees for Executive Officer seats must have a minimum of three years of experience serving on the Executive Board to be eligible for President, Vice President, or Secretary

Elected Board Members are required to attend board meetings as often as necessary to address and fulfill the Association's business, as well as to attend the Annual Training Conference. Routinely board meetings are usually held bi-monthly in a central location.

If a board member misses two consecutive meeting or two meetings in any given conference year (beginning from one annual conference until the next annual conference) unless there are extenuating circumstance as determined by the majority of the Board voting, the President shall declare the position vacant.
